"Worthing just edged out in NSL round 3 thriller in Guildford"

With solid results in round 1 and 2 of the NSL (Arena National Swimming League) Worthing swimming club were looking towards a 3rd place or better in the final round at the Guildford spectrum on Saturday. Worthing were back to a full strength squad with the return of Karen Chan and Ben Goddard.

Out of 50 events (individual and relay team) Worthing scored 3 first and 4 second places. Event winners were Harry Burnell (50m freestyle), Karen Chan (100m freestyle) and Ben Goddard (50m backstroke).

Everything was going to plan as Worthing were in 3rd place after event 47. The final three relay events again proved to be Worthing's undoing with the team finishing in 7th place overall just behind Dorking, Bognor Regis and Maidenhead.

Worthing have over the three NSL rounds this year showed enormous promise and depth (particularly in the 12 year and under age group swimmers boys and girls). WSC head coach Nic Piper and his team of coaches/teachers are gradually building a strong squad of swimmers that will be back battling it out with the best in 2010.
