“Worthing raises the roof”

On Saturday 18th June 2011 Worthing swimming club hosted the Sussex league gala at the Aquarena. The Sussex league is where three teams face off against each other with two swimmers racing at a time. With winning the first Sussex league gala at St Bede's, Worthing set out to keep their 100% record in this league.

With 50% of the races over two lengths and not the usual 50m but 66m we had a good home advantage and with the water polo clashing on the night we were very much relying on a good team performance.

Nicolas Savill and Michelle Hepworth showing how well they have improved this year by getting 31 and 42 points out of their individual events making them the top boy and girl swimmers for the night.

At the end of a thrilling night of swimming, Worthing came first with a total of 412 which was 89 points ahead of Bognor in second and 147 points ahead of Lewes in third. This result shows how well Worthing swam on the night. Winning this gala and the one at St Bede's means that it is now down to the third and final gala to decide who gets promoted to division one.
